1. Why have I been prescribed Aruma Flower Titan?

Aruma Flower Titan contains the active ingredients tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), as well as smaller amounts of other cannabinoids and terpenes. Aruma Flower Titan is used to treat several different medical conditions.

2. What should I know before I use Aruma Flower Titan?

Do not use if you have ever had an allergic reaction to tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), cannabidiol (CBD), or any of the ingredients listed at the end of the CMI.

Do not use if you have a serious mental health disorder, or a serious heart, liver, kidney, or lung problem.

Talk to your doctor if you have any other medical conditions, take any other medicines, are pregnant or plan to become pregnant, or are breastfeeding.

5. What should I know while using Aruma Flower Titan?

Things you should do	 Inform any doctor, dentist or pharmacist or other health professionals you visit that you are using Aruma Flower Titan prior to starting any new medication. Use Aruma Flower Titan exactly as prescribed by your doctor. Call your doctor immediately if you notice your condition getting worse.
Things you should not do	 Do not exceed the recommended dose prescribed by your doctor. Do not give Aruma Flower Titan to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.
Driving or using machines	 Do not drive or use any machines or tools. It is illegal to drive a motor vehicle in Australia while if you are taking medicinal cannabis.
Drinking alcohol	Avoid alcohol when taking Aruma Flower Titan.
Looking after your medicine	 Store Aruma Flower Titan in a cool dry place away from moisture, heat, or sunlight. Store out of reach of children.

6. Are there any side effects?

Common side effects of Aruma Flower Titan include feeling dizzy or tired; feeling or being sick; diarrhea or eating more or less than usual. Serious side effects of Aruma Flower Titan include changes to how you think and to your emotions.

1. Why have I been prescribed Aruma Flower Titan?

Aruma Flower Titan contains the active ingredient tetrahydrocannabinol (THC).

The cannabinoids in Aruma Flower Titan act on very specific targets in the body, known as cannabinoid receptors. These receptors are found naturally throughout the body, in most tissues and organs, but they are especially numerous in the brain and nervous system.

Aruma Flower Titan can be used to treat a number of medical conditions, including:

- Fits (seizures) caused by epilepsy
- Nausea or vomiting due to cancer treatment
- Some inflammatory gastrointestinal conditions that cause stomach pain
- Muscle spasticity (spasming or stiffness) and pain due to Multiple Sclerosis
- Pain that may last a long time and is not related to cancer (unremitting neuropathic pain)
- End of life care (palliation)
- Shaking and/or involuntary movements related to Parkinson's Disease
- Loss of appetite due to HIV or cancer therapy

Your doctor may prescribe Aruma Flower Titan for another purpose.

Ask your doctor if you have any questions about why Aruma Flower Titan has been prescribed for you.

2. What should I know before I use Aruma Flower Titan?

Warnings

Do not use Aruma Flower Titan if:

- you have a serious mental health disorder
- you have a serious heart problem such as angina, a previous heart attack, poorly controlled high blood pressure or a problem with your heart rate or heartbeat
- you are allergic to tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), cannabidiol (CBD), or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet

Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine

Check with your doctor if you:

- are under 18 years of age
- have any other medical conditions such as liver or kidney problems
- have family members with a history of a serious mental health disorder
- are over 65 years old

During treatment, you may be at risk of developing certain side effects. It is important you understand these risks and how to monitor for them. See additional information under Section 6. Are there any side effects?

Pregnancy and breastfeeding

Do not use Aruma Flower Titan if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Check with your doctor if you intend to become pregnant or intend to breastfeed.

3. What if I am taking other medicines?

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any medicines, vitamins, or supplements that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket, or health food shop.

Some medicines may interfere with Aruma Flower Titan and affect how it works.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are using medicines for:

- anxiety or sleeping problems (for example diazepam, triazolam, zopiclone, zolpidem, buspirone or St John's Wort (an herbal preparation))
- muscle spasms (such as baclofen)
- bacterial infections (antibiotics such as rifampicin, clarithromycin)
- epilepsy or nerve pain (such as phenytoin, phenobarbital, carbamazepine)
- high cholesterol (known as statins; for example, atorvastatin or simvastatin)
- fungal infections (such as itraconazole, fluconazole and ketoconazole)
- HIV infection (for example ritonavir)
- thinning your blood (known as coumarins; for example, warfarin)
- heart problems (for example, digoxin or medicines known as betablockers, including bisoprolol, propranolol)
- inflammation (known as corticosteroids; for example, hydrocortisone, beclomethasone, prednisolone)
- putting you to sleep or relaxing your muscles before an operation or surgery (such as propofol)
- contraception or cancer treatment (hormone medicines such as ethinyloestradiol, levonorgestrel or dydrogesterone)

Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure about what medicines, vitamins or supplements you are taking and if these affect Aruma Flower Titan.

4. How do I use Aruma Flower Titan?

How much to take

- Your doctor will tell you how much Aruma Flower Titan to use.
- A titration period is required to reach optimal dose.
 The number and timing of doses will vary between patients.
- Your doctor will provide you with a treatment schedule based on your needs.

Follow the instructions provided and use Aruma Flower Titan until your doctor tells you to stop.

How to take Aruma Flower Titan

Aruma Flower Titan comes in a 10g medical grade plastic container. You may need to purchase a vapouriser and scale separately.

- Step 1: Commence dosing at time of day recommended by doctor.
- Step 2: Remove the tamper evident cap from the container.
- Step 3: Remove a small dried cannabis flower from the container.
- Step 4: Break off 0.1g of the dried cannabis flower.
- Step 5: Grind or chop the material to an even, fine consistency.
- Step 6: Heat vapouriser to desired temperature (typically around 180-190°C)

- Step 7: Lightly pack ground cannabis material into vapouriser, allowing room for airflow to pass through the material.
- Step 8: Take 1-2 inhalations. Wait 15 minutes to assess effects.
- Step 9: Repeat as needed

If you use too much Aruma Flower Titan

If you think that you have used too much Aruma Flower Titan, you may need urgent medical attention.

You should immediately:

- contact your doctor, or
- phone the Poisons Information Centre (by calling 13 11 26), or
- go to the Emergency Department at your nearest hospital.

You should do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning.

5. What should I know while using Aruma Flower Titan?

Things you should do

- Tell your doctor if you change any other medicines you are taking, including any medicines, vitamins, or supplements that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket, or health food shop
- Tell your doctor if you are pregnant (or planning to become pregnant) or breastfeeding.

Call your doctor immediately if you:

- notice your condition getting worse
- notice any of the serious side effects listed under Section <u>6</u>. Are there any side effects?

Inform any doctor, dentist, or pharmacist you visit that you are using Aruma Flower Titan prior to starting any new medication, including non-prescription medications.

Things you should not do

- do not take more Aruma Flower Titan than your doctor has told you to
- do not give Aruma Flower Titan to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you

Driving or using machines

Do not drive or use any machines or tools while taking Aruma Flower Titan. THC can be detected in saliva for many hours after administration and in urine for several days after use.

Drinking alcohol

Avoid alcohol when using Aruma Flower Titan.

Alcohol may interact with Aruma Flower Titan, affecting co-ordination, concentration, and ability to respond quickly.

Looking after your medicine

Follow the instructions on the container on how to take care of your medicine properly.

Store in a cool dry place away from moisture, heat, or sunlight. Refrigeration is not required.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Getting rid of any unwanted medicine

If you no longer need to use this medicine or it is out of date, take it to any pharmacy for safe disposal.

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date.

6. Are there any side effects?

All medicines can have side effects. If you do experience side effects, most of them will be minor and temporary. However, some side effects may need medical attention.
